

In Memoriam

“Jack” Duffy

On December 10th, 1983, Philadelphia Police Officer John “Jack” Duffy was killed when his patrol wagon was struck by another patrol car as the vehicles responded to an officer needs assistance call. Jack was just 22 years old. AOH Division #6 honors Officer Duffy as well as all of the other police officers, fire fighters, and soldiers who have courageously lost their lives.
